## Dear

I am writing to acknowledge receipt of your email dated 2nd August 2021 requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000) regarding 52 weeks for elective treatment.

On the same day we contacted you via email as we required the following clarification:

Do you mean patients who are currently waiting for treatment (current waiting list) or patients who have waited over 52weeks by the time they received treatment (activity), in addition, we also require a time frame in order to collate any information.

You replied via email with the following:

'Please could you provide both sets of information, for both waiting list and current activity. Please could you provide information from March 2020 to present?'

As of 1<sup>st</sup> November 2014 University Hospitals of North Midlands NHS Trust (UHNM) manages two hospital sites – Royal Stoke University Hospital, and County Hospital (Stafford). Therefore the response below is for the two sites combined from that date where appropriate.

- Q1 Please could you provide a breakdown of the number of patients who have waited over 52 weeks for elective treatment at your Trust; by?
  - i. Ethnicity
  - ii. Whether or not English is their first language
  - iii. Whether or not they have a learning disability
- A1 The data for Ethnicity and Learning Disabilities is held. We do not have the information available regarding first language of the patient. Total number of patients who waited over 52 weeks to receive first definitive treatment on an RTT pathway between 1st March 2020 and 30th June 2021
