I am writing in response to your email dated 14th March 2019 (received into our office 15th March) requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000) regarding use of staff banks.

On 2<sup>nd</sup> April 2019 we contacted you via email as we required clarification on what information you required.

On 4<sup>th</sup> April 2019 you replied via email with the following:

"Thank you for your email. Please be advised that if your Trust has an in-house managed bank service for the staffing categories listed, then question no. 1b), 2a), 2b), 2c), 2d), 2e), 2f), 2g) and 2h) are not applicable and therefore, do not require a response.

However please continue to respond to question no. 3 and no. 4".

As of 1<sup>st</sup> November 2014 University Hospitals of North Midlands NHS Trust (UHNM) manages two hospital sites – Royal Stoke University Hospital, and County Hospital (Stafford). Therefore the response below is for the two sites combined from that date where appropriate.

## Q3 I am writing to you under a Freedom of Information Act request regarding the Trust's use of staff banks as a key part of the effective management of temporary staffing across the NHS and in turn the reduction of agency spend.
