I am writing in response to your email dated 6<sup>th</sup> January 2020 requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000) regarding programmes or services.

As of 1<sup>st</sup> November 2014 University Hospitals of North Midlands NHS Trust (UHNM) manages two hospital sites – Royal Stoke University Hospital, and County Hospital (Stafford). Therefore the response below is for the two sites combined from that date where appropriate.

Q1 In accordance with the FOI act, I request information about your NHS acute hospital Trust.

I would like to know;

Which programmes or services (either internally developed or commissioned) to tackle high attendance rates at A&E do you possess and are in operation? E.g. To identify and address High Intensity Users (HIUs) at A&E, redirection to other services such as Minor Injury Units, etc.

- A1 UHNM uses the following programme; High Volume Service Users (HSVU) for Royal Stoke ED is part of this group currently we look at 220 people and this will increase next financial year to 410 people who have 8 or more attendances to ED. County Hospital (Stafford) utilise the High Intensity Users.
- Q2 How effective have they been for the Trust?
- A2 The FOI Act 2000 is for the release of information that is held/recorded and does not cover the opinions of persons regarding suppliers, systems or procedures, therefore this information is not held.
