I am writing to acknowledge receipt of your email dated 9th June 2021 requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000) regarding maternity.

As of 1st November 2014 University Hospitals of North Midlands NHS Trust (UHNM) manages two hospital sites – Royal Stoke University Hospital, and County Hospital (Stafford). Therefore the response below is for the two sites combined from that date where appropriate.

Q1 I write under the Freedom of Information Act to request the following information with regards to the Trust's maternity unit:

On how many occasions was the maternity unit closed to new admissions in 2020/21?

- A1 None, however at the County Site the Free Standing Midwifery Birth unit was closed due to covid and staffing reasons. The service remains suspended as we have vacancies and need to review the staffing model. It is part of a wider review of maternity services across Staffordshire for transformation which started pre Covid and is being revived with consultation events planned. Bookings and admissions to maternity services have continued as it is only the birth element which is currently not offered. All women who had planned to birth at FMBU have access to RSUH services
- Q2 For each such occasion, please state the duration of and the reason for the closure.
- A2 Not applicable- County site = 20th March 2020 on-going
