I am writing to acknowledge receipt of your email dated 15th February 2022 requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000) regarding Master vendor.

The University Hospitals of North Midlands Trust is committed to the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

However, the NHS is facing unprecedented challenges relating to the coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic at the current time. Understandably, our resources have been diverted to support our front-line colleagues who are working tremendously hard to provide care for our patients, and to those in need of our services.

We strive to be transparent and to work with an open culture. But at this time, whilst care of our patients and the safety of our staff takes precedent, it is likely that responses to some requests for information will be delayed. We apologise for this position in advance, and will endeavour to provide you with as much information as we can, as soon as we are able.

The Information Commissioners Office has recognised the current situation in the NHS.

On 17th February 2022 we contacted you via email as we required clarification on what you meant by Permanent Agency Staff Manager"

On 20th February 2022 (received into our office 21st February) you replied via email with:

'To clarify; by "Permanent Agency Staff Managers" I mean the person (or persons) that are in charge of speaking with healthcare recruitment agencies to hire permanent healthcare staff for your trust. By "Temporary Agency Staff Managers" I mean the person (or persons) that are in charge of speaking with healthcare recruitment agencies to hire temporary (locum) healthcare staff for your Trust'.

As of 1st November 2014 University Hospitals of North Midlands NHS Trust (UHNM) manages two hospital sites – Royal Stoke University Hospital, and County Hospital (Stafford). Therefore the response below is for the two sites combined from that date where appropriate.

I'm currently conducting research to finalise a business plan which will enable us to assist the NHS/you with dramatically cutting down on agency spend and shift cancellations. Meaning not only would spend decrease but simultaneously patient care and safety would increase. To move into the next stages we require further information







and direct feedback from Agency Staff Bank Managers to hear their thoughts and if they believe it's something that will help strengthen the NHS recruitment process. I have attached an excel document as a template guide for you to input your answers to the following questions:

Q2: The exemption which has been relied upon is section 40(2) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 with regards to the name, job title, telephone number and email address of the <u>non</u> UHNM staff individuals.

The disclosure of this information is subject to balancing the legitimate interest to disclose against the rights of the individuals. Upon balancing these two factors, we have found that the rights of the individual outweigh the legitimate interest to disclose. Therefore, it would be unfair to the data subject if this information is disclosed. The disclosure of the name, job title, telephone number and email address would not add anything further to this request for information.

Furthermore, it would be unfair to disclose the name, job title, telephone number and email address of non UHNM staff individuals to the general public.

The individual would expect a right to privacy. They would only expect that their name, job title, telephone number and email address are disclosed to the relevant people in connection with Trust business and also in relation to the discharge of the responsibilities involved in their post. It would not be reasonable to disclose their name, job title, telephone number and







email address to the general public for <u>non</u> UHNM staff. Furthermore, the release of this information may also lead to a greater number of unsolicited correspondences.

The first condition under section 40(3A) has been contravened as it would not be fair to disclose the name, job title, telephone number and email address of <u>non</u> UHNM staff individual. Therefore, the name, job title, telephone number and email address of the individual, has been withheld.
