## Dear

I am writing in response to your email dated 28<sup>th</sup> September 2020 requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000) regarding cancelled operations.

On 5<sup>th</sup> October 2020 you contacted us via email with the following amendment to your request:

I recently submitted an FOI request to your Trust regarding cancelled operations from March - September 2020 and the same period in 2019.

"I have realised that I can make my request more specific, and I would like therefore to please amend it to the following questions:

- a) How many operations in total has your Trust cancelled between 1<sup>st</sup> March and 30<sup>th</sup> September 2020 and can you give a breakdown of reasons for the cancellations? How many were urgent operations? b) How many operations in total has your Trust cancelled between 1<sup>st</sup> March and 30<sup>th</sup> September 2019 and can you give a breakdown of reasons for the cancellations? How many were urgent operations? c) How many operations in total has your Trust cancelled for Under 16s between 1<sup>st</sup> March and 30<sup>th</sup> September 2020, and can you give a breakdown of reasons for the cancellations? How many were urgent operations?
- d) How many operations in total has your Trust cancelled for Under 16s between 1<sup>st</sup> March and 30<sup>th</sup> September 2019, and can you give a breakdown of reasons for the cancellations? How many were urgent operations?

I'm sorry to add to the complexity of the request and am happy for the foi legal timeframe for response to start again from now".

We replied via email the same day asking you to supply the reference number that we would have acknowledged this request with in order to make these amendments and to avoid a delay in response.

On 14<sup>th</sup> October 2020 we again contacted you requesting the reference number as UHNM receives an excessive amount of requests and a reference number is required to avoid delay.

On 21<sup>st</sup> October 2020 after an intensive search of our system we located your request; we contacted you via email advising you of the reference number as asked for the following clarification on your new request:

Please supply clarification on the specific meaning of where you say *urgent*, is it on an urgent pathway or a non-elective admission?

On 27<sup>th</sup> November 2020 you replied via email with the following:







"Thank you for your emails. I'm sorry, for some reason they have been going to my spam folder.

When I say urgent I mean non-elective."

As of 1<sup>st</sup> November 2014 University Hospitals of North Midlands NHS Trust (UHNM) manages two hospital sites – Royal Stoke University Hospital, and County Hospital (Stafford). Therefore the response below is for the two sites combined from that date where appropriate.
