I am writing in response to your email dated 2nd January 2021 sent to Pals team, (received into our office 4th January) requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000) regarding Covid-19.

On 4th January 2021 we contacted you via email to inform you that the FOI Act sets out a twenty working day timescale for requests to be completed by. We will always try to complete your request within this timeframe. We will let you know whether the Trust holds the information you have requested, and we will contact you as soon as possible if we are delayed in our response for some reason. If we require further information from you or we need you to further explain your request before we can continue to process it we will also contact you.

As we count working days and your request didn't come into our office until 4th January 2021 the 20 day end line is 1st February 2021 and NOT 29th January 2021 as stated in your email.

On 4th January 2021 we contacted you via email as we required clarification on Q1; did you mean all patients or just covid-19 ones?

On the same day you replied via email the following:

"Question 1 is referring to ALL deaths at all your Hospitals (not specifically Covid). Basically irrespective of cause.

Question 2 and 3 are specifically linked to cause as per request".

I can neither confirm nor deny whether the information you have requested is held by the Trust in its entirety. This is because the information requested in questions 2 and 3 is not held centrally, but may be recorded in individual health/death records. In order to confirm whether this information is held we would therefore have to individually access all individual health/death records within the Trust and extract the information where it is present. We therefore estimate that complying with your request is exempt under section 12 of the FOI Act: cost of compliance is excessive. The section 12 exemption applies when it is estimated a request will take in excess of 18 hours to complete. We estimate that accessing and reviewing all individual health/death records and then extracting relevant information would take longer than the 18 hours allowed for. In addition to the section 12 exemption the Trust is also applying section 14 (1) exemption: oppressive burden on the authority







As of 1st November 2014 University Hospitals of North Midlands NHS Trust (UHNM) manages two hospital sites – Royal Stoke University Hospital, and County Hospital (Stafford). Therefore the response below is for the two sites combined from that date where appropriate.

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000, please provide me with the following information, as I require this information for a project I am currently undertaking:

I can see the figures that you publish online, but these are deaths within 28 days of a positive Covid-19 test, so they could have died from other causes.

I just want to know the exact figures between 1st February 2020 until the 31st December 2020 for the following questions:

Question 1

How many people have died in each of your hospitals between 1st February 2020 until the 31st December 2020?

A1 These are all hospital deaths for the period 1st February 2020 until the 31st December 2020 as per your above clarification.

Total = 2842

How many people have died in your hospitals from Covid-19 alone between 1st February 2020 until the 31st December 2020? (As in they died ONLY due to Covid-19 and did not have any comorbidities at the time of death.) with the Data filtered:

By Hospital showing deaths per month per hospital between 1st February 2020 until the 31st December 2020.

A2 Section 12 exemption as detailed above. Note: we are counting COVID-19 deaths as per the national guidance. The figure, and a description of the definition we are using, are published daily and can be found via the link below:
