I am writing in response to your email dated 2nd October 2020 requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000) regarding windows

As of 1st November 2014 University Hospitals of North Midlands NHS Trust (UHNM) manages two hospital sites – Royal Stoke University Hospital, and County Hospital (Stafford). Therefore the response below is for the two sites combined from that date where appropriate.

- Q1 Who is responsible for your Windows 10 desktop migration? Name/Role and contact details if available.

- Q2 How many end users do you have across the Trust?

- Q3 How many Windows end point devices do you have?

- Q5 Does the Trust still use Java and Internet Explore based applications?
- UHNM declines to answer this question under section 24(1) which states "Information which does not fall within section 23(1) is exempt information if the exemption from section 1(1) (b) 2 is required for the purpose of safeguarding national security." Furthermore withholding this information is also supported by the Freedom of Information Amendment (Terrorism and Criminal Intelligence) Act 2004
- Q6 Is the Trust Cyber Essentials Plus accredited?
