I am writing in response to your email dated 18th Sept ember 2020 (received into our office 21st September) requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000) regarding digital dictation system

As of 1st November 2014 University Hospitals of North Midlands NHS Trust (UHNM) manages two hospital sites – Royal Stoke University Hospital, and County Hospital (Stafford). Therefore the response below is for the two sites combined from that date where appropriate.

- Q1 We have the following information about your trust's digital dictation system status.
 - System type Digital dictation
 - Supplier name Winscribe
 - System name Winscribe
 - Date installed 2017-04-01
 - Contract expiration 2021-03-31

Can you confirm if the digital dictation information above is still correct?

- A1 The above is correct however please note that we also use Medisec digital dictation system. Installation was June 2018. Contract ends 31.3.2021 with a rolling contract for annual renewals.
- Q2 If applicable, what is the current contract expiration date with your supplier?
- A2 31st March 2021, this is the same of Winscribe and Medisec (as stated in answer 1)
- Q3 If there has been a system replacement, or a new system implementation, please can you let us know the new supplier and system name?
- A3 See below:
 - 3M Medisec
 - Medisec digital dictation
- Q4 Also, when was the new system installed and when will the current contract expire?
- A4 See below:
 - Install/implementation March 2019
 - Contract ends 31st March 2021







- Q5 If applicable,
 - can you let us know who supplies your digital dictation hardware devices?
 - how many digital dictation devices does your trust have?
 - when was the procurement date of the digital dictation devices?
- A5 Phillips speechmike devices are predominantly used, we do not have a full asset register of these devices as departments are able to purchase them themselves and they do not have a material asset value.

The original procurement for devices was in 2010, further devices deployed alongside Medisec digital dictation March 2019 as well as departments purchasing ad hoc devices, which is ongoing.
