I am writing in response to your email dated 14<sup>th</sup> January 2019 requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000) regarding patients with Parkinson's.

On 15<sup>th</sup> January 2019 we contacted you via email as we required clarification on what you meant by "how many of your current patients" – is this patients currently under our care or patients who are currently in hospital as an inpatient?

On the same day you replied via email with the following:

As of 1<sup>st</sup> November 2014 University Hospitals of North Midlands NHS Trust (UHNM) manages two hospital sites – Royal Stoke University Hospital, and County Hospital (Stafford). Therefore the response below is for the two sites combined from that date where appropriate.

Q1 Parkinson's UK would like to know how many of your current patients with Parkinson's at Royal Stoke University Hospital and County Hospital live in Shropshire? Could this data be broken down by hospital?
