I am writing in response to your email dated 30th August 2019 requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000) regarding Upper and Lower GI Procedures. (This request previous acknowledged reference number 315-1920)

On the same day we contacted you via email as UHNM had received several requests that are asking for similar information that we believe are from the same person/company, therefore as we have received no response, we are contacting you to inform you that under section 12 of the FOI Act we were aggregating these requests on Upper and Lower GI Procedures and external supplier or party to deliver Endoscopy and/or Gastroenterology services/activity. (Ref 313-1920 acknowledged 29th August 2019)

The section 12 exemption states:

The authority can combine related requests received within a period of 60 consecutive days from:

- The same person or
- People who appear to be acting in concert or in pursuance of a campaign.

As of 1st November 2014 University Hospitals of North Midlands NHS Trust (UHNM) manages two hospital sites – Royal Stoke University Hospital, and County Hospital (Stafford). Therefore the response below is for the two sites combined from that date where appropriate.
