I am writing to acknowledge receipt of your email dated 14th December 2021 requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000) regarding AHP agency usage.

As of 1st November 2014 University Hospitals of North Midlands NHS Trust (UHNM) manages two hospital sites – Royal Stoke University Hospital, and County Hospital (Stafford). Therefore the response below is for the two sites combined from that date where appropriate.
