I am writing in response to your email dated 16<sup>th</sup> November 2019 (received into our office 18th November) requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000) regarding breast screening.

On 18<sup>th</sup> November 2019 we contacted you via email as we required a timeframe in order to collate the information.

On 12<sup>th</sup> December 2019 you replied via email the following:

"Thank you for your email. To confirm, the request is not really attributed to a timeframe but will be how the service currently runs".

As of 1<sup>st</sup> November 2014 University Hospitals of North Midlands NHS Trust (UHNM) manages two hospital sites - Royal Stoke University Hospital, and County Hospital (Stafford). Therefore the response below is for the two sites combined from that date where appropriate.
